

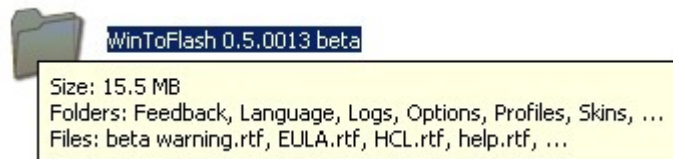
Install Windows OS from USB flash drive

Last Updated On : January 01, 2010

To install Windows OS (XP/ 2003/2008/ Vista/ Win7) directly from USB flash drive, follow the steps given below.

Use atleast 1GB USB flash drive for XP installation and 4 GB for Windows 7 and Vista.

Download latest version of **WinToFlash** from [HERE](#). Or (alternate [download](#)). After extracting compressed file, open this folder:



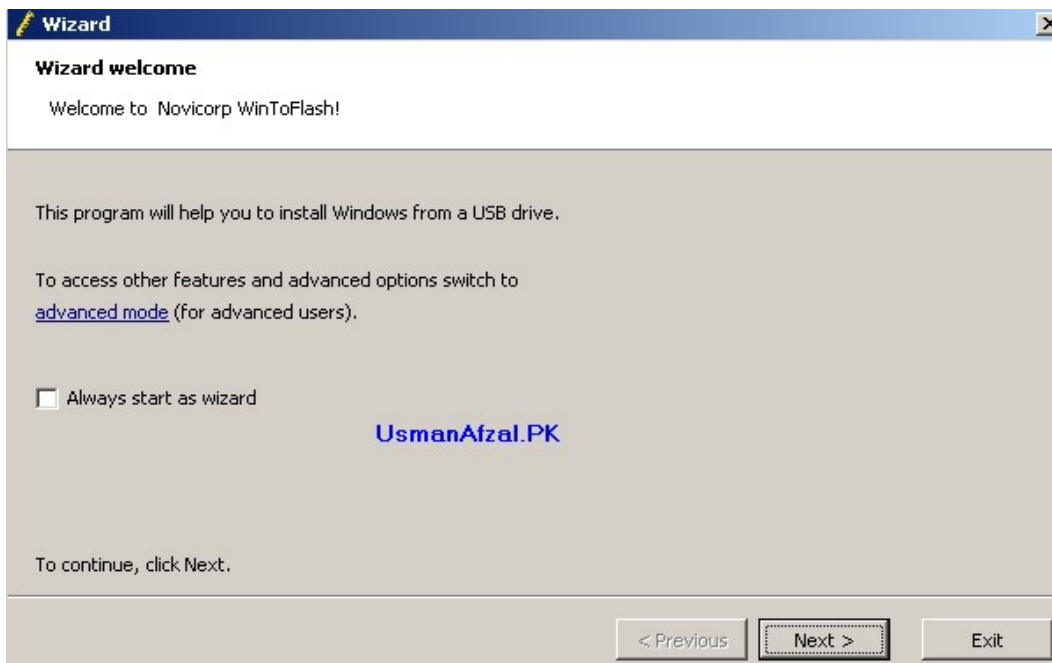
Start the application:



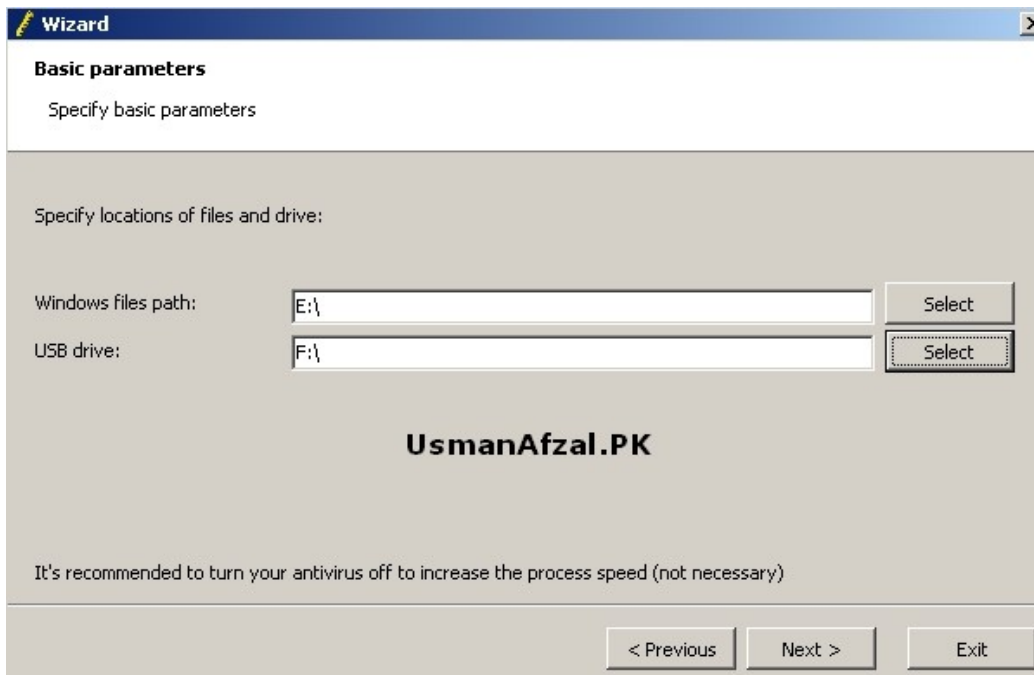
This screen will appear:



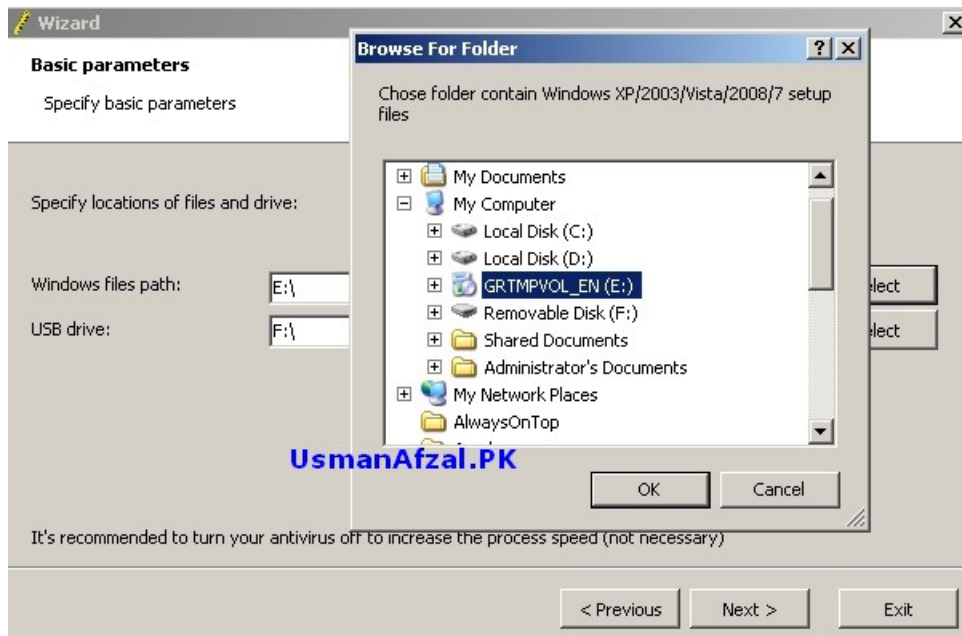
Click on “Windows setup transfer wizard” button:



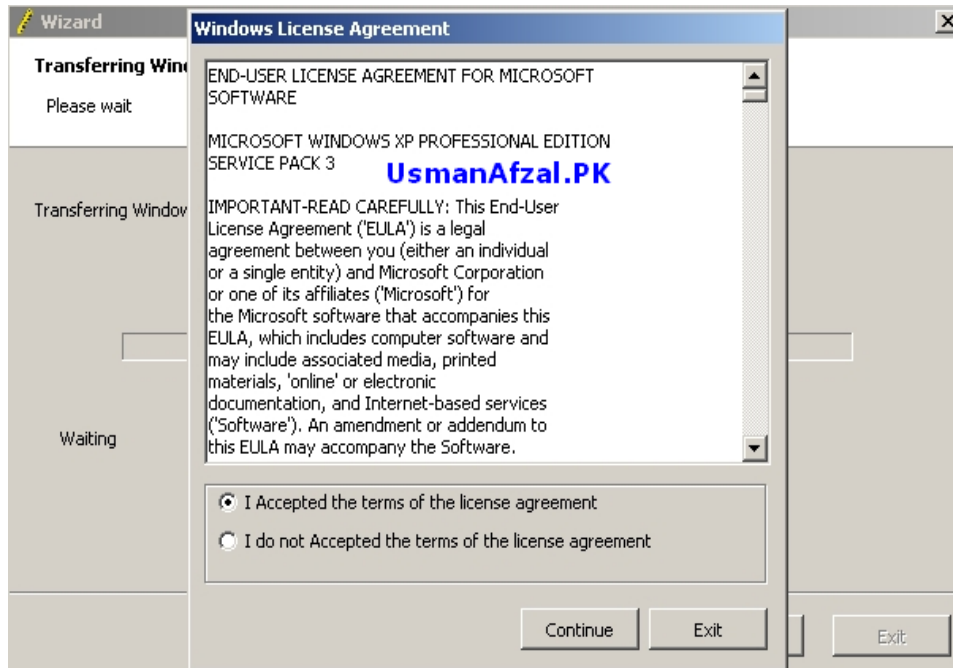
Press "Next":



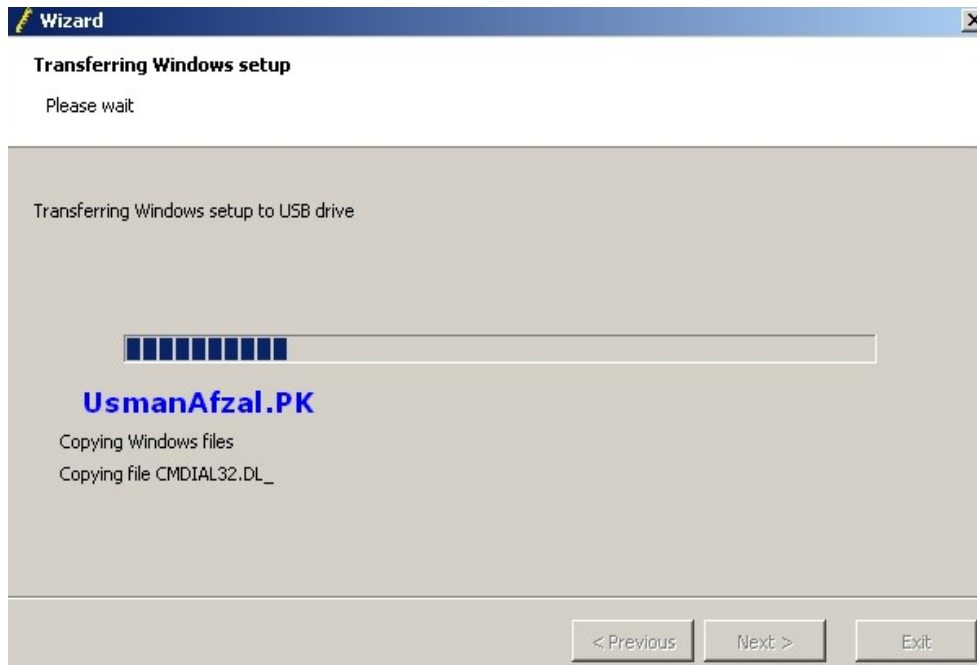
Select the Windows CD:
Click "OK" and select USB flash drive:



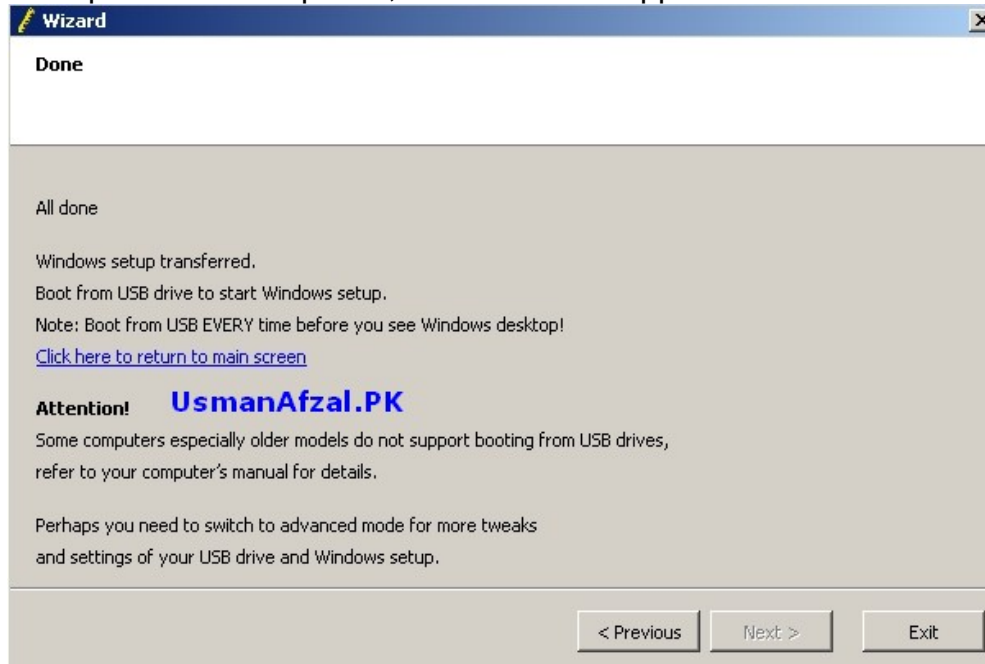
Click “OK” and Press “Next” button:



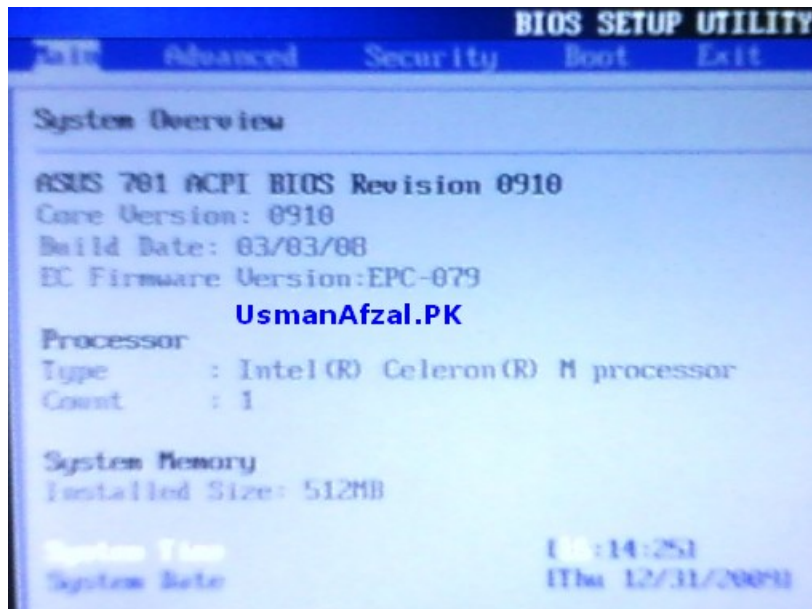
Select “Accept” option and click “Continue” button to start the process:



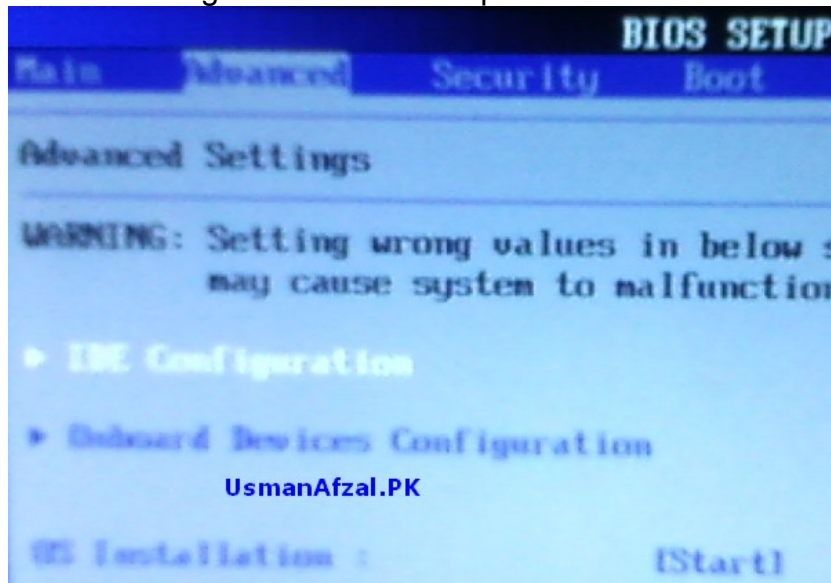
This process (may take about 20 minutes) depends on your Windows CD and USB drive speed. When the process is completed, this screen will appear:



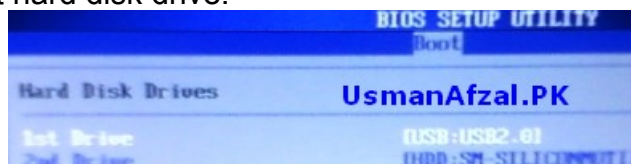
Press "Exit" button. Remove USB drive from PC and insert it into USB port of your netbook (or any PC). Switch ON your netbook (e.g Asus EeePC netbook) and keep pressing F2 to go to bios setting.



Go to "Advanced" tab and change OS Installation option from finish to Start:



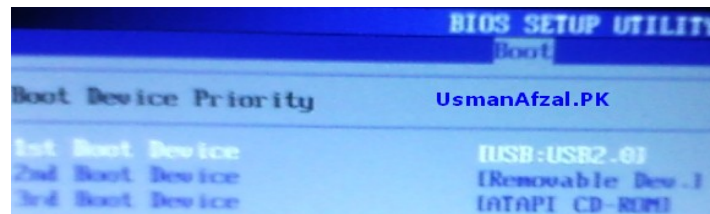
Select USB drive as first hard disk drive:
